

Noncommercial (17 Affected Trips)


- 4 launched after the park opened




#### Noncommercial Trips – 8 Year Perspective




#### Noncommercial Passengers – 8 Year Perspective



#### Noncommercial User-Days – 8 Year Perspective








## Prediction for Former Waitlist Members Remaining Eligible for Special Assistance




#### **How 4,274 Who Transferred to Lottery Have Fared**

#### Possible Changes to Noncommercial Permit System

Show Cancellations

 Modify lottery site to show cancellations when they occur to give advance notice before lotteries are announced.

Schedule Lotteries Schedule Lotteries at regular times each month (e.g. every 2<sup>nd</sup> Tues-Thurs)


2x Chances

 Encourage the listing of PATLs (Potential Alternate Trip Leaders) by doubling points on lottery applications that list PATLs. Currently only 18% of applicants list PATLs.

Maximum Trip Lengths • To help with TAOTS, shorten the <u>noncommercial</u> maximum trip lengths from 21 to 18\* for the last half of April and increase the maximum trip lengths from 18-21 for the last half of September.
